Appellants, Gillian Denmark and James Denmark ("Denmark") brought suit in Federal District Court in the Eastern District of Louisiana against Appellee Nicholas Aris Tzimas ("Tzimas") seeking damages for malicious prosecution, libel and slander and tortious interference with business relationships. The district court dismissed the action, finding that it lacked personal jurisdiction

over Tzimas and that the Eastern District of Louisiana was a *forum non conveniens*.
