We review rule 11 sanctions for abuse of discretion. The district court's reasons are ably set forth in its Memorandum Ruling of September 24, 1993, only a portion of which the appellant has bothered to include in the record excerpts. We find no abuse of discretion in the imposition of sanctions. The order appealed from is AFFIRMED.
