Derrick Minafee argues that the district court abused its discretion in dismissing his 42

U.S.C. § 1983 complaint as frivolous based on the complaint being time-barred by the statute of limitations. After thorough review of the record, the opinion of the district court, and the brief, we find that the dismissal of the complaint as frivolous should be affirmed because, regardless of timeliness, the action is frivolous. *See Lynch v. Cannatella*, 810 F.2d 1363, 1376 (5th Cir. 1987). AFFIRMED.
