PER CURIAM:*

George Don McGuffey has filed a motion to proceed in forma pauperis (IFP) on his appeal of the district court's grant of judgment as a matter of law for the defendant in McGuffey's civil rights action. The court previously granted conditional IFP status to McGuffey for the preparation of a trial transcript at government expense. After a review of the record, we conclude

that McGuffey has not demonstrated that he will present a nonfrivolous issue on appeal. Therefore, his IFP status is revoked and the appeal is dismissed. See Hailes v. Equitable Life Assur. Soc. of U.S., 729 F.2d 1037 (5th Cir. 1984).
