PER CURIAM:*

Russell Mills, Jr., appeals the dismissal with prejudice of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 complaint. Mills alleged that while he was a pretrial detainee and while he was incarcerated as an inmate, the defendants denied him adequate medical treatment. After trial before the magistrate judge, full findings were made by order dated July 6, 1995. The district judge then confirmed

those findings by its order of August 15, 1995. It has been determined that Mills received reasonable medical treatment and that none of the defendants were indifferent to his medical needs. Mills shows no constitutional deprivation. Nor does he show how he was prejudiced by the absence of the doctor he wished to testify.
