PER CURIAM:*

Ismael Martinez appeals from the district court's dismissal of his civil rights complaint.

Martinez challenges state-court proceedings concerning the foreclosure of his property and the issuance of a forcible entry and detainer judgment. Because Martinez is attempting to collaterally attack a state-court judgment, the district court lacked subject-matter jurisdiction to review his

claims. <u>See Liedtke v. State Bar of Tex.</u>, 18 F.3d 315, 317 (5th Cir.), <u>cert. denied</u>, 115 S. Ct. 271 (1994). Accordingly, the judgment of the district court dismissing Martinez's complaint with prejudice is AFFIRMED.
