This is a direct criminal appeal from Keith Fisher's conviction for conspiracy to possess with intent to distribute in excess of 500 grams of cocaine. Fisher contends that the district court erred by denying his motion to suppress the cocaine law enforcement officers discovered after a purportedly improper search. We have reviewed the record and the briefs of the parties and AFFIRM the district court's ruling denying Fisher's motion to
