After considering the record presented for review, including the Hearing Officer's Report on Objections to Conduct Affecting the Results of the Election with Findings and Recommendations, the Decision and Certification of the Collective Bargaining Representative by the Board, and the Decision and Order that Clark United Corporation Cease and Desist from Refusing To Bargain with the Union, and the briefs of the parties, we

conclude that the Board acted reasonably within its discretion in overruling the Company's election objections, and, therefore, properly found that the Company violated Section 8(a)(5) and (1) of the National Labor Relations Act by refusing to bargain with the duly certified union.

Accordingly, the orders of the National Labor Relations Board in these cases are AFFIRMED and ENFORCED.
