Texas prisoner Jeffrey Wayne Tyree, # 0138675, appeals the dismissal of his civil rights suit challenging the judicial acts of Judge Fitzwater. For the reasons adopted by the district court, we conclude that the appeal is frivolous. <u>Tyree v.</u> <u>Fitzwater</u>, No. 3:96-CV-0297-R (N.D. Tex. Mar. 6, 1996).
