PER CURIAM:*

Ted Lawrence Robertson appeals the dismissal of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action as barred by the relevant statute of limitations. Robertson's original complaint, which he filed on January 19, 1995, alleged that on February 8, 1992, the defendants unlawfully arrested him, falsely imprisoned him, and illegally searched his home, car, truck, and person, thereby

violating his civil rights. The limitations period for filing suit on Robertson's claims began to run on February 8, 1992, and ended on February 9, 1994. See Rodriguez v. Holmes, 963 F.2d 799, 803 (5th Cir. 1992). The district court did not err by dismissing Robertson's § 1983 action as barred by the statute of limitations.

Robertson's motion for summary judgment is DENIED.

AFFIRMED.
