Plaintiff-appellant Alfred L. Bush (Bush) appeals the district court's grant of summary judgment in favor of his former employer, defendant-appellee Rice Food Markets, Inc. (Rice), dismissing Bush's Title VII claim of racially motivated discharge. Bush does not complain of the dismissal of his claim of intentional

infliction of emotional distress. After review of the briefs and record, we conclude that the district court correctly granted summary judgment for Rice. All of Bush's contentions on appeal are adequately analyzed and refuted in the district court's well-considered and thorough opinion. Accordingly, the judgment of the district court is

AFFIRMED.
