David Lee Cook, Texas prisoner #435179, appeals the district court's denial of habeas corpus relief. Cook argues that he was deprived of his Sixth Amendment right to confront witnesses against him at trial and that the prosecutor's comments constituted misconduct that rendered his trial fundamentally unfair in violation of the Fourteenth Amendment.
