PER CURIAM:*

Feldon Bonner, II, appeals the district court's denial of his motion for a preliminary injunction. Bonner has not shown a likelihood of success on the merits and irreparable injury warranting a preliminary injunction, and the district court did not abuse its discretion in denying his motion. Lakedreams v.

Taylor, 932 F.2d 1103, 1106-07 (5th Cir. 1991). The decision of the district court is AFFIRMED.

Bonner has also moved this court to appoint counsel, to conduct a hearing en banc on the denial of his motion for a preliminary injunction, to direct the district court to conduct a hearing on his motion for a preliminary injunction, and to direct the court to conduct a hearing pursuant to Spears v. McCotter, 766 F.2d 179 (5th Cir. 1985). Bonner's motions are DENIED.
