PER CURIAM:*

Texas state prisoner Kenneth W. Maggard, #536922, appeals the dismissal of his suit pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1406(a) for lack of venue. Having reviewed the record and Maggard's brief, we hold that the district court did not abuse its discretion in dismissing

Maggard's action without prejudice. See Lowery v. Estelle, 533 F.2d 265, 267 (5th Cir. 1976).

Because the appeal is frivolous it is DISMISSED. 5th Cir. R. 42.2.¹ We warn Maggard that any additional frivolous appeals filed by him or on his behalf will invite the imposition of sanctions. To avoid sanctions, Maggard is further cautioned to review any pending appeals to ensure that they do not raise arguments that are frivolous.
