PER CURIAM:*

Allen G. Phelps appeals from the district court's judgment in favor of the defendant in his suit under general maritime law and the Jones Act, 46 U.S.C. § 688. Phelps argues that the district court's findings that no act or omission of the defendant nor unseaworthy condition of the GLOMAR HIGH ISLAND VIII caused or contributed to Phelps' injury were clearly erroneous. We have reviewed the record and the briefs and AFFIRM
