Edward Giovanni, #96746, appeals the district court's grant of the defendants' supplemental motion for summary judgment and dismissal of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 suit. He contends that genuine issues of material fact remain with respect to his claims regarding the body cavity search conducted on November 8, 1992, and a disciplinary report, which he asserts was "fabricated" in

retaliation for his exercising his First Amendment right to seek access to the courts. We have reviewed the record and briefs and AFFIRM the district judge's dismissal for essentially the same reasons adopted by the district judge. Giovanni v. Vannoy Et Al., No. 93-69-B-M2 (M.D. La. Feb. 28, 1996).
