Cornell Boykin, Louisiana state prisoner #117301, appeals from the district court's grant of the defendants' motions for summary judgment and to dismiss in his civil rights proceeding. Boykin argues that defendant Gay subjected him to cruel and unusual punishment and acted with deliberate indifference to his medical needs by refusing to provide him with his medication on one occasion and subjected him to an excessive use of force when he allegedly threw Boykin to the floor and dragged him. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly,
