Ligia Morice Zavalney filed two motions to proceed <u>in forma</u> <u>pauperis</u> in appeals docketed as cause No. 96-40168 and No. 96-40169. This court must examine the basis of its jurisdiction on its own motion if necessary. <u>Mosley v. Cozby</u>, 813 F.2d 659, 660 (5th Cir. 1987). Zavalney's appeals must be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction, as they are not taken from a final or otherwise appealable order. <u>See</u> 28 U.S.C. §§ 1291, 1292. The court directs the clerk's office to consolidate Zavalney's appeals in No. 96-40168 and No. 96-40169. <u>See Holloway v. Walker</u>, 800 F.2d 479, 480 (5th Cir.), <u>cert. denied</u>, 479 U.S. 984 (1986). The appeals are DISMISSED.
