Cecil Lee Russell (Texas prisoner #472051) appeals the dismissal of his civil rights suit for the failure to pay a prior district court sanction. We have reviewed the record and Russell's contentions, and we find no abuse of discretion.

Gelabert v. Lynaugh, 894 F.2d 746, 747-48 (5th Cir. 1990). The dismissal is AFFIRMED.

We caution Russell that any frivolous appeals filed by him or on his behalf will invite the imposition of sanctions. To avoid sanctions, Russell is further cautioned to review any
