Gustavo Andrade, #57391-079, has appealed the denial of his "Motion to Reduce Sentence and to Correct an Illegal Sentence Pursuant to Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure Rule 35(a)(1)."

The notice of appeal was not filed within ten days of entry of judgment. See Fed. R. App. P. 4(b). It would be futile for this court to remand to the district court to determine whether there was excusable neglect in filing the late notice of appeal, see

<u>United States v. Golding</u>, 739 F.2d 183, 184 (5th Cir. 1984), because even if there is excusable neglect and the appeal is timely, we would dismiss the appeal as frivolous. The district court had no jurisdiction to entertain the Rule 35 motion.
