PER CURIAM:*

Terrance Lamar Williams pleaded guilty to aiding and abetting the possession of cocaine base with intent to distribute. Williams argues on appeal that the Government breached his plea agreement by failing to move for a downward departure at sentencing pursuant to U.S.S.G. § 5K.1.1. We have reviewed the record and the briefs of the parties and find no breach of the plea agreement. United States v. Cerverizzo, 74
