PER CURIAM:*

James Richard Brown (TDCJ # 701163) appeals the jury verdict in favor of the defendants in his prisoner civil rights suit. He argues that the jury verdict was "against" the evidence and that the trial judge allowed prejudicial and inflammatory trial tactics.

Because Brown has failed to provide a transcript of the trial and has "declined" to cite relevant legal authorities, he can make no showing of error with regard to his claims. See Phillips v. Frey, 20 F.3d 623, 627 (5th Cir. 1994); Richardson v. Henry, 902 F.2d 414, 416 (5th Cir. 1990). As it is frivolous, the appeal is dismissed. See Howard v. King, 707 F.2d 215, 219-20 (5th Cir. 1983); 5th Cir. R. 42.2.
