Gregory House, TDCJ # 411028, moves for leave to appeal in forma pauperis, arguing that the district court erred by dismissing his claim that he improperly was disciplined.

Reviewing House's issues in light of the appellate record, we conclude that the issues are without arguable merit and, thus, are frivolous. See Jackson v. Dallas Police Dep't, 811 F.2d 260, 261 (5th Cir. 1986). Accordingly, House's motion is DENIED.
