Juan E. Cisneros appeals the district court's determination that it lacked jurisdiction to review the Commissioner's decision not to reopen his prior claims for disability benefits. Cisneros argues that the district court erred in granting the Commissioner's motion to dismiss his complaint because he alleged violations of his substantive and procedural due process rights.
