Rafael Vasquez, Texas prisoner #738214, appeals from the district court's judgment dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 civil rights complaint as frivolous. This court must examine sua sponte the basis of its own jurisdiction if necessary. Mosley v. Cozby, 813 F.2d 659, 660 (5th Cir. 1987). Because the record shows that Vasquez did not file a timely notice of appeal, his appeal is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction. See Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(1); Mosley, 813 F.2d at 660. Because this court lacks
