PER CURIAM:\*

Ramiro Riojas appeals from the district court's order  
revoking the magistrate judge's order of release pending trial.  
The district court's decision rests on its conclusion that Ramiro  
Riojas presents a danger to any other person or the community and  
no conditions will reasonably assure safety, and that Ramiro

Riojas presents a risk of flight and no conditions will reasonably assure his appearance as required. See 18 U.S.C. § 3142(e) and (f). The district court's conclusion that no conditions of release will assure Ramiro Riojas' appearance is supported by the record. See United States v. Rueben, 974 F.2d 580, 586 (5th Cir. 1992). The district court's detention order as to Ramiro Riojas is AFFIRMED.
