Stuart H. Smith, Jr., appeals the district court's dismissal of his claim under the Federal Tort Claims Act for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. Smith also appeals the denial of attorney fees following a partial summary judgment in his favor under the Freedom of Information Act and he argues that the district court should have ordered the United States Coast Guard

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to produce the "entire file" related to its investigation of a marine accident in which Smith was involved. We have reviewed the record and the briefs of the parties and AFFIRM for essentially the same reasons set forth by the district court.

Smith v. United States, No. CA 95-1950 (E.D. La. October 6, 1995; November 14, 1995; and December 4, 1996). Smith's request for discovery and production of documents is DENIED.
