Manuel Flores, federal prisoner #02184-095, appeals from the district court's denial of his motion for reduction of sentence pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2). He argues that he is entitled to a reduction in his sentence based upon two retroactive amendments, 371 and 484, to the U.S. Sentencing Guidelines. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, the judgment is AFFIRMED for essentially the
