P. 12(b)(5) and 12(b)(6). Blanchard appeals, but does not challenge the basis for the district court's dismissal. Because Blanchard does not raise any error of the district court, he presents no grounds for appeal to this court. Blanchard's appeal is without arguable merit and is frivolous. See Howard v.
