PER CURIAM:*

Juan Carlos Zuluaga appeals from the district court's order affirming the magistrate judge's pretrial detention order. The district court's decision rests upon the conclusion that Zuluaga did not rebut the presumption that no condition or combination of

conditions will reasonably assure his presence at trial. See 18 U.S.C. § 3142(e). This conclusion is supported by the proceedings below. See United States v. Rueben, 974 F.2d 580, 586 (5th Cir. 1992). Accordingly, the district court's order is AFFIRMED.
