Alejandro Lopez, Texas prisoner # 336330, appeals the district court's denial of his petition for a writ of habeas corpus filed under 28 U.S.C. § 2254. Lopez's appeal is from the district court's resolution of the merits of the claims he raised in a second, or successive, habeas petition. A prisoner seeking to file a successive habeas petition must first obtain leave from this court to do so. See 28 U.S.C. § 2244(3)(A). Because Lopez did not obtain such permission from this court, the district

court was without jurisdiction to entertain the petition. <u>See id.</u> Accordingly, the appellee's motion to dismiss is GRANTED, the judgment is VACATED, and the case is REMANDED to the district court with instructions to dismiss the petition.
