Appellant Martha Aleyda Stanford appeals from an adverse summary judgment dismissing her discrimination and retaliation claim brought under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. § 2000, et seq., ("Title VII"), as well as her state law claim for intentional infliction of emotional distress.

After a careful de novo review of the record, the summary judgment evidence presented to the district court, and the briefs on appeal, we find no merit in appellant's arguments advanced in opposition to the dismissal of her Title VII claim or her state

law claim. We affirm for the reasons set forth in the very detailed and well reasoned Order by the magistrate judge granting the defendant's motion for summary judgment, dated December 18, 1997.
