Melvin Gamage, Mississippi prisoner # 58703, appeals the district court's order transferring his successive 28 U.S.C. § 2254 habeas corpus petition to this court for a determination whether the district court should be authorized to consider it. In transferring the petition, the district court relied on 28 U.S.C. § 1631. Under these circumstances, the transfer order is a nonappealable interlocutory order. See Brinar v. Williamson,
