PER CURIAM:*

The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Eddie Lee Finley has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, ___ F.3d ___, No. 09-41281, 2011 WL 309173 (5th Cir. Jan. 31, 2011). Finley has not filed a response. We have reviewed counsel's brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected therein. We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review.
