that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to file an out-of-time motion for reconsideration is GRANTED; his motion for reconsideration also is GRANTED. Our order of May 16, 2011, in this case is RESCINDED. Counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
