PER CURIAM:*

The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Wenseslao Martinez-Jimenez (Martinez) has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967). Because Martinez was deported from the United States before the *Anders* motion and brief were

filed, he was not served. Our independent review of the record and counsel's brief discloses no nonfrivolous issue for appeal. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED in part as frivolous, *see* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2, and in part as moot. *See United States v. Rosenbaum-Alanis*, 483 F.3d 381, 383 (5th Cir. 2007).
