States. We have reviewed counsel's brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected therein. We concur with counsel's assessment that Aranda Soto's appeal of his conviction presents no nonfrivolous issue. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED in part as frivolous, see 5TH CIR. R. 42.2, and in part as moot, see United States v. Rosenbaum-Alanis, 483 F.3d 381, 382-83 (5th Cir. 2007).
