With respect to Rosales-Hernandez's request to be moved to a prison in California, this court does not have the authority to determine prisoner location. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
