The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Adam Vargas moved for leave to withdraw and filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Vargas did not file a response. We previously carried counsel's motion with the case and ordered that counsel file a supplemental *Anders* brief addressing certain issues or, alternatively, a brief on the merits addressing any

nonfrivolous issues that counsel deemed appropriate. Counsel has filed a motion for reconsideration of that order.

We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for reconsideration of our prior order is GRANTED, and our prior order requesting more briefing is VACATED; counsel's motion to withdraw is GRANTED; counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein; and, the APPEAL IS DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR.
