tions of the record, and Castillo's response. We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for review. Accordingly, the motion to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the appeal is DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
