counsel. We have reviewed counsel's brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected therein, as well as Klarer's response, in which he seeks to challenge his sentence. We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the appeal is DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. The motion for appointment of counsel is DENIED as moot.
