concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no nonfrivolous issue for appellate review. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the appeal is DISMISSED. See 5TH CIR. R. 42.2. Godbolt's request to strike counsel's Anders brief and for an extension of time to file a pro se brief is DENIED as untimely because it was filed after counsel filed an Anders brief. See United States v. Wagner, 158 F.3d 901, 902-03 (5th Cir. 1998).
