Plaintiff-Appellant Mohmad Tamimi filed suit against Defendant-Appellee Giancarlo Messina, Defendant William Pletch, Defendant Carlos Bethencourt, and Defendant Carlos Bethencourt Entertainment, LLC, for breach of contract, fraud, and negligent misrepresentation. Messina moved to dismiss for lack of personal jurisdiction, and the district court granted
