Because the judgment was entered on October 22, 2024, he had until November 21, 2024, to file a timely notice of appeal. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2107(a). However, Bryant did not file his notice until November 25, 2024, and he was denied an extension of time to appeal. Accordingly, we lack jurisdiction. *See*

Hamer v. Neighborhood Hous. Servs. of Chi., 583 U.S. 17, 19 (2017). The appeal is DISMISSED, see Bowles v. Russell, 551 U.S. 205, 213 (2007), and Bryant's motions for leave to proceed in forma pauperis and for appointment of counsel are DENIED.
