The Federal Public Defender appointed to represent Samuel Suess Trevino has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). We granted Trevino's motions to access sealed portions of the record and for extensions of time to file a response, but he has

not filed a response. However, we have considered arguments related to the underlying proceedings that are included in Trevino's motions. We have reviewed counsel's brief and the relevant portions of the record reflected therein, as well as Trevino's arguments. Accordingly, counsel's motion for leave to withdraw is GRANTED, counsel is excused from further responsibilities herein, and the appeal is DISMISSED. *See* 5TH CIR. R. 42.2.
