Athina Karahogitis appeals a summary judgment dismissing her claims that TPUSA, Inc. discriminated against her based on sex, disability, and age when it terminated her employment; failed to accommodate her disability; breached her employment agreements; and fraudulently induced her into entering a new employment agreement.
