MEMORANDUM


Complainant, a pro se litigant, complains that by granting the defendant's motion to dismiss his lawsuit, the subject United States District Judge "took away my rights to be heard by [a] jury."

The allegation relates directly to the merits of the judge's decision, and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
