## MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a pro se litigant, has filed a complaint in which he makes no specific allegations against the subject United States District Judge; rather, complainant attaches 167 pages of documents on the general topic of the alleged ineligibility for office of a former President and two United States Senators.<sup>1</sup>


The complaint is frivolous and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii).

This is complainant's third frivolous complaint in five months. Complainant is WARNED that should he file a further merits-related, conclusory, frivolous, or repetitive complaint, his right to file complaints may be suspended and, unless he is able to show cause why he should not be barred from filing future complaints, the suspension will continue indefinitely. See Rule 10(a), Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings.

<sup>1</sup> Even if the complaint were construed as being aimed at the validity of the subject judge's appointment by a President purportedly ineligible to hold office, a 28 U.S.C. §§ 351-364 complaint is not the appropriate mechanism for challenging that appointment.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
