MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a federal prisoner, complains that in denying his motion for authorization to file a successive 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion, the three subject United States Circuit Judges “did not review all of my [motion],” “changed and falsified” his argument, “and did not review [the trial record].”

The complaint relates directly to the merits of decisions or procedural rulings and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
