MEMORANDUM

Complainant, a state prisoner, complains that the subject United States District Judge “denied all my motions filed of [sic] imminent danger of serious physical injury. . . . I deserve help. I am in danger of serious injury, and I’m disabled. I have received no justice.”

The complaint relates directly to the merits of decisions or procedural rulings and is therefore subject to dismissal under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii).

Judicial misconduct proceedings are not a substitute for the normal appellate review process, nor may they be used to obtain reversal of a decision or a new trial.

An order dismissing the complaint is entered simultaneously herewith.
